The SafeChoice Domestic Violence Program served over 14,427 victims via 24-hour crisis line in this fiscal year, and provided shelter with 7,501 bed nights in fiscal year 2012, children's and legal advocacy, counseling, support groups, and community education.

The CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate Program) enabled over 280 volunteers this year to advocate for neglected, abused, or abandoned children in the court system. In 2012, CASA provided over 24,000 advocacy hours through their independent recommendations to the court for 860 children.

This fiscal year the Sexual Assault Program served 7,108 victims and their families through 24-hour advocacy, individual therapy, support groups, and community education. A total of 4,307 calls were fielded and prevention education offered to 5,063 participants.
